Culture Moves Europe Match-Making Sessions!

Programme

This document summarises each residency project of the conditionally selected hosts present at the Culture Moves Europe Match-Making Sessions. Here, you can find the exact day and time of each presentation.*

What are the Match-Making Sessions?

These are webinars that will bring together residency hosts (selected through the Culture Moves Europe call for residency hosts) and potential participants.

Each host will present their residency project and share their contact information. Interested artists and cultural professionals can join the session to learn more about these opportunities. As this is a networking event, it's up to participants to establish and maintain contact. The Culture Moves Europe team is not responsible for the selection of participants, it's up to the hosts to select their artists and cultural professionals.

36 hosts will be split into 2 sessions:

- 15 September 2023: 14H00 to 16H00 CEST (Brussels time)

What is Culture Moves Europe? It's a Creative Europe project that provides mobility grants for artists and cultural professionals in all 40 Creative Europe countries. It covers the sectors of architecture, cultural heritage, design and fashion design, literary translation, music, performing arts and visual arts.

What about the Residency Action and the Call for Residency Hosts?

The residency action is a Culture Moves Europe initiative specifically aimed at supporting legal entities in implementing a residency project that welcomes international artists and cultural professionals. The residency project must take place in one of the Creative Europe countries, and the participating artists and cultural professionals must be legal residents in a Creative Europe country, different from the one where the residence takes place.

The call for residency hosts is the open call through which Culture Moves Europe selects legal entities who wish to implement a residency project.

The residency projects can last from 22 days to 300 days. There are 3 types depending on number of days:

- Short-term duration residency: from 22 to 60 days
- Medium-term duration residency: from 61 to 120 days
- Extended duration residency: from 121 to 300 days
